THE WORD-NUMBER PLACEMENT

This is a treatment of the occurrence in the King James Bible where the word depicting a number appears in that exact place in the verse.

For example take the word “THIRTEENTH” as found in Esther 9:1 Now in the twelfth month, that is the month Adar, on the “THIRTEENTH” day of the same, when the king’s commandment... etc. Count the words in the verse the “thirteenth” word IS the word “thirteenth”. I have found this phenomenon a total of 269 times in the Bible. The average Bible is 1,200 pages which means that this “exact number–word placement” occurs on an average of once every four pages. This to me was quite remarkable.

The King James Bible is a supernatural book and God’s fingerprints are found everywhere in it. The more I read and study it the more I am convinced that this is God’s perfect and preserved word for the last universal language of English prior to the Second Coming of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

I have listed the occurrences below. I have noted where there is no occurrence for a particular number and I did not include the occurrences of the numbers such as “Forty” that appeared in the “fourth” position or the number “Fifty” that appears in the “fifth” position, etc, had I done so the count would have risen to 304 times as opposed to the 269 times of the true occurrence of the word-number relationship. I pray this work will add more wonder and amazement to your love of the scripture.

Exo 28:27 And two *other* rings of gold thou shalt make, and shalt put them on the two sides of the ephod underneath, toward the forepart thereof, over against the *other* coupling thereof, above the curious girdle of the ephod.

Exo 30:4 And two golden rings shalt thou make to it under the crown of it, by the two corners thereof, upon the two sides of it shalt thou make *it*; and they shall be for places for the staves to bear it withal.

Gen 40:13 Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head, and restore thee unto thy place: and thou shalt deliver Pharaoh's cup into his hand, after the former manner when thou wast his butler.

Gen 40:19 Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thy head from off thee, and shall hang thee on a tree; and the birds shall eat thy flesh from off thee.

Jdg 7:20 And the three companies blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers, and held the lamps in their left hands, and the trumpets in their right hands to blow *withal*: and they cried, The sword of the LORD, and of Gideon.

Jdg 7:22 And the three hundred blew the trumpets, and the LORD set every man's sword against his fellow, even throughout all the host: and the host fled to Bethshittah in Zererath, *and* to the border of Abelmeholah, unto Tabbath.

Num 7:24 On the third day Eliab the son of Helon, prince of the children of Zebulun, *did offer*:

1Ki 15:33 In the third year of Asa king of Judah began Baasha the son of Ahijah to reign over all Israel in Tirzah, twenty and four years.

Jos 19:10 And the third lot came up for the children of Zebulun according to their families: and the border of their inheritance was unto Sarid:

2Ki 11:6 And a third part *shall be* at the gate of Sur; and a third part at the

gate behind the guard: so shall ye keep the watch of the house, that it be not broken down.

2Ch 23:5 And a third part *shall be* at the king's house; and a third part at the gate of the foundation: and all the people *shall be* in the courts of the house of the LORD.

Num_7:7 Two wagons and four oxen he gave unto the sons of Gershon,

according to their service:

1Ki_7:34 And *there were* four undersetters to the four corners of one base: *and* the undersetters *were* of the very base itself.

2Ki_7:3 And there were four leprous men at the entering in of the gate: and they said one to another, Why sit we here until we die?

1Ch_26:18 At Parbar westward, four at the causeway, *and* two at Parbar.

2Ch_9:25 And Solomon had four thousand stalls for horses and chariots, and twelve thousand horsemen; whom he bestowed in the chariot cities, and with the king at Jerusalem.

Eze_10:21 Every one had four faces apiece, and every one four wings; and the likeness of the hands of a man *was* under their wings.

Dan_1:17 As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams.

Dan_10:4 And in the four and twentieth day of the first month, as I was by the side of the great river, which *is* Hiddekel;

2Ch_20:26 And on the fourth day they assembled themselves in the valley of Berachah; for there they blessed the LORD: therefore the name of the same place was called, The valley of Berachah, unto this day.

Ezr_8:33 Now on the fourth day was the silver and the gold and the vessels weighed in the house of our God by the hand of Meremoth the son of Uriah the priest; and with him *was* Eleazar the son of Phinehas; and with them *was* Jozabad the son of Jeshua, and Noadiah the son of Binnui, Levites;

Jer_52:6 And in the fourth month, in the ninth *day* of the month, the famine was sore in the city, so that there was no bread for the people of the land.

Mat_14:25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea.

“**FIVE**” is the fifth word in the verse 16 times.

Gen. 18:28 Peradventure there shall lack five of the fifty righteous?

Exo 26:9 And thou shalt couple five curtains by themselves, and six curtains by themselves, and shalt double the sixth curtain in the forefront of the tabernacle.

Exo 36:10 And he coupled the five curtains one unto another: and *the other* five curtains he coupled one unto another.

Num_3:47 Thou shalt even take five shekels apiece by the poll, after the shekel of the sanctuary shalt thou take *them*: (the shekel *is* twenty gerahs:)

Jos_8:12 And he took about five thousand men, and set them to lie in ambush between Bethel and Ai, on the west side of the city.

1Ki_6:6 The nethermost chamber *was* five cubits broad, and the middle *was* six cubits broad, and the third *was* seven cubits broad: for without *in the wall* of the house he made narrowed rests round about, that *the beams* should not be fastened in the walls of the house.

2Ch_25:1 Amaziah *was* twenty and five years old *when* he began to reign, and he reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name *was* Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.

2Ch_27:1 Jotham *was* twenty and five years old when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also *was* Jerushah, the daughter of Zadok.

2Ch_36:5 Jehoiakim *was* twenty and five years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem: and he did *that which was* evil in the sight of the LORD his God.

Isa_19:18 In that day shall five cities in the land of Egypt speak the language of Canaan, and swear to the LORD of hosts; one shall be called, The city of destruction.

Mar_8:19 When I brake the five loaves among five thousand, how many baskets full of fragments took ye up? They say unto him, Twelve.

Luk_9:14 For they were about five thousand men. And he said to his disciples, Make them sit down by fifties in a company.

2Ch_29:33 And the consecrated things *were* six hundred oxen and three thousand sheep.

Job_5:19 He shall deliver thee in six troubles: yea, in seven there shall no evil touch thee.

Jer_52:23 And there were ninety and six pomegranates on a side; *and* all the pomegranates upon the network *were* an hundred round about.

Joh_2:6 And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.

“SIXTH” is the sixth word in the verse 4 times.

1Ch_24:9 The fifth to Malchijah, the sixth to Mijamin,

1Ch_26:3 Elam the fifth, Jehohanan the sixth, Elioenai the seventh.

1Ch_27:9 The sixth *captain* for the sixth month *was* Ira the son of Ikkesh the Tekoite: and in his course *were* twenty and four thousand.

Luk_23:44 And it was about the sixth hour, and there was a darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour.

“SEVEN” is the **seventh** word in the verse **14** times.

Gen_7:10 And it came to pass after seven days, that the waters of the flood were upon the earth.

Gen_23:1 And Sarah was an hundred and seven and twenty years old: *these were* the years of the life of Sarah.

Gen_41:24 And the thin ears devoured the seven good ears: and I told *this* unto the magicians; but *there was* none that could declare *it* to me.

Gen_41:30 And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land;

Exo_2:16 Now the priest of Midian had seven daughters: and they came and drew *water*, and filled the troughs to water their father's flock.

Jdg_14:17 And she wept before him the seven days, while their feast lasted: and it came to pass on the seventh day, that he told her, because she lay sore upon him: and she told the riddle to the children of her people.

Jdg_20:16 Among all this people *there were* seven hundred chosen men lefthanded; every one could sling stones at an hair *breadth*, and not miss.

Act_10:3 He saw in a vision evidently about the ninth hour of the day an angel of God coming in to him, and saying unto him, Cornelius.

Gen_32:15 Thirty milch camels with their colts, forty kine, and ten bulls, twenty she asses, and ten foals.

Gen_45:23 And to his father he sent after this *manner*; ten asses laden with the good things of Egypt, and ten she asses laden with corn and bread and meat for his father by the way.

Num_7:86 The golden spoons *were* twelve, full of incense, *weighing* ten *shekels* apiece, after the shekel of the sanctuary: all the gold of the spoons *was* an hundred and twenty *shekels*.
